We urgently seek your help in assisting a current Whitman HS senior, who is battling an aggressive form of cancer and requires a bone marrow transplant.

Please consider registering with Be the Match as potential bone marrow or peripheral blood stem cell donor (PBSC). It's simple to do. People with a background similar to this student's ethnic background, which is part Filipino and part European, aged 18-44, are thought to be especially good matches. Even if your registration cannot help this student, it likely could help others; any medical team can check the registry for a match. Be the Match may then contact you for further screening for a bone marrow or peripheral blood stem cell (PBSC) match for someone in need.

District Boundary Study Analysis Update

The Board of Education completed the initial phase of data analysis, community engagement and community outreach events. They are now moving into Phase 2, which will consist of continued data analysis and testing to build on previous analyses, as well as the creation of an interactive tool that examines opportunities and potential trade-offs between key performance indicators such as school facility utilization, student travel and student demographics. Over the next several months, the BOE will conduct multiple regional open meetings across the county (dates and locations TBD). They will also conduct targeted outreach to meet with hard-to-reach communities and other key stakeholders. For more information about this process, please
